



Supreme Governor of the Loyal Order of Moose to visit Caroline Lodge 2610

Caroline Moose Lodge 2610 has been selected to host Bruce J. Berger, Supreme Governor of the Loyal Order of Moose, during his travels through the state of Virginia. This visit is scheduled for 7:00pm on Thursday, October 1, 2020.

Brother Berger rose to become the Moose Fraternity's Chief Presiding Officer on June 26, 2020, elected by vote of Supreme Lodge delegates to a one-year term, at the Fraternity's 13224 International Convention, held online for the first time in its history. Bruce had served as Supreme Jr. Governor since July 2019, elected to that post at the 131st International Convention in Las Vegas, NV. Bruce has served on the Supreme Council, the Fraternity's corporate Board of Directors, since 2012.

Bruce joined Quakertown, PA Lodge 1622 in 1982, and served three terms as Governor. He later transferred to Sellersville, PA Lodge 1539, where he is an Honorary Past Governor. He also holds memberships in Mooseheart, IL Lodge 2655, Chicora, PA Lodge 962 and Port Allegany, PA Lodge 460.

Bruce elevated to North Penn Moose Legion 124, later changing to William Penn Moose Legion 3. He also holds membership in Mecca Moose Legion 9, Western Pennsylvania Moose Legion 1 and North Jersey Moose Legion 2. He has held all chairs in the Moose Legion unit, including Secretary from 1990-1995 and North Moose from 1989-1990. He also has earned the Moose Legion Medal of Honor.

Bruce served the Pennsylvania Moose Association in numerous capacities and was its President from 2004-2005. He also served as Deputy Supreme representing the Pennsylvania Moose Association in 1996-1997. He served on the International Community Service Committee from 2000-2004. A member of the 125 Division of the Moose 25 Club, Bruce received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1988 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1998. Bruce is employed by Secant Medical and resides in Quakertown, PA with his wife, Donna. Aside from his Moose duties, he enjoys following car racing. Bruce and Donna have a daughter and two granddaughters.
