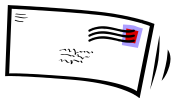

District Meeting: Our next meeting will be at the South Norfolk Moose Lodge on April 9, 2018 starting at 12:00pm. Let's have a good showing from Suffolk. A free meal will be served to those in attendance.

Election of Officers: The LOOM will hold election of new lodge officers on April 4th at the regular meeting starting at 8:00pm. Come out and vote for your choice of officers.

Membership Drive: We hope that all have not forgotten; we now have a membership in conjunction with Power House Gaming.
