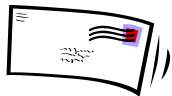

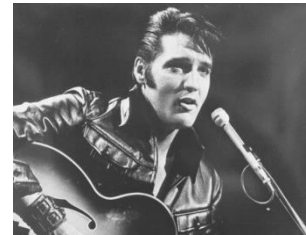
SENIOR REGENT NEWS:
