We had a great year; we have accomplished moving ranking #1 in the state and #2 in the Nation.

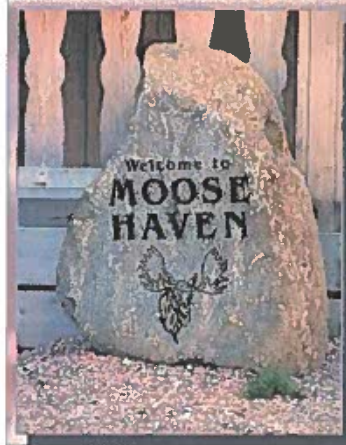
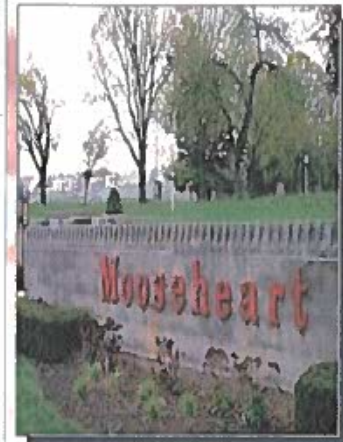
