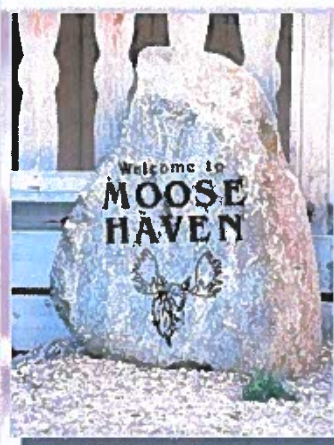
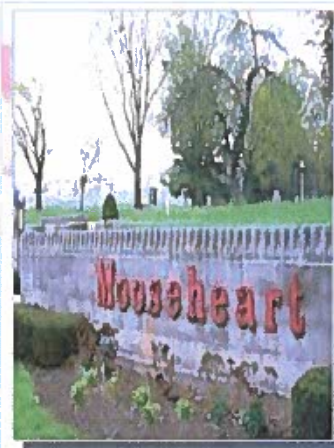


Moose—On A Mission

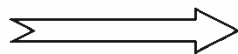

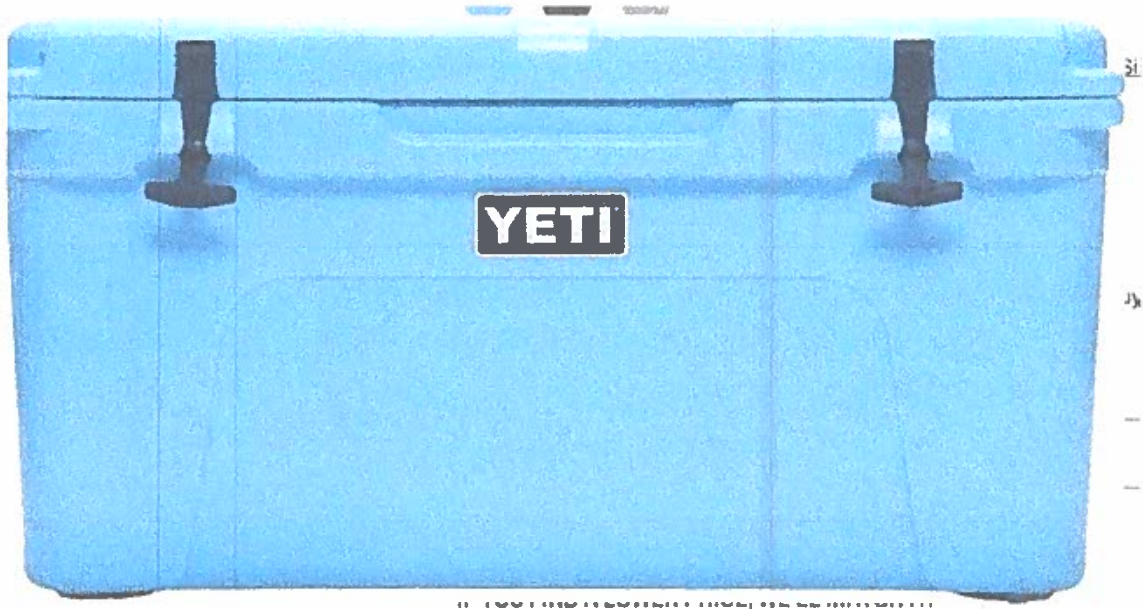
