The Portsmouth VA Chapter 966 is offering all of our coworkers a chance to become a LIFETIME MEMBER of BOTH the ONE MOOSE and WOMEN OF THE MOOSE at a discounted cost (meaning you will NEVER pay dues again to either lodge OR chapter after purchasing the lifetime membership!)! This incentive is available from July 16, 2020 until April 1, 2021.

Even better? You can make installment payments on this price through the chapter! Here are the requirements:

1. You MUST be a member of the Portsmouth VA Chapter 966 in good standing (meaning your dues are paid up and you are active on our rolls). If not in good standing, you must pay back dues to return to good standing OR re-enroll to qualify.
2. You must ALREADY be a member of our chapter to qualify. New members (new applicants to the Women of the Moose) may only qualify after they pay the one year dues in advance and are accepted into the chapter by ballot.
3. You MUST pay the fees/installments at the lodge. You CANNOT send any money toward this incentive to Moose International. This is a CHAPTER INCENTIVE and NOT a Moose International incentive, therefore they will return your money and tell you that you have not sent enough money =) Likewise, this offer is not available online.
4. The discounted price of your membership is scaled by the number of years of service to the fraternity and is outlined in the chart:
