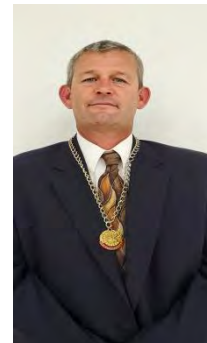
## Governor's Corner

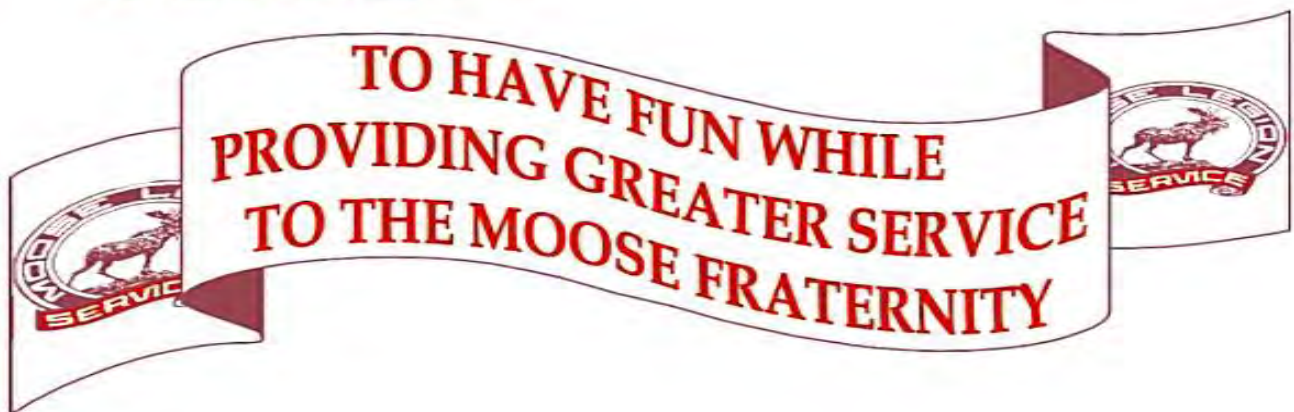
