The Virginia Moose Association is amazing. Chapters and Lodges across the state had 75 students participate this year. Of those who participated, 18 students completed the program requirements at the regional level. Those 18 students talked to over 3,000 4-9 year old's between September 2017 and February 2018. The state will be sending six participants to the International Congress.

I am pleased to announce that Sophia Higgins from Winchester has been selected as one of six Virginia Moose Association \$1,000 scholarship winners. Sophia attends Mt. View Christian Academy and will represent the State at the International Youth Awareness Congress in Boston, MA, April 26 - April 30. 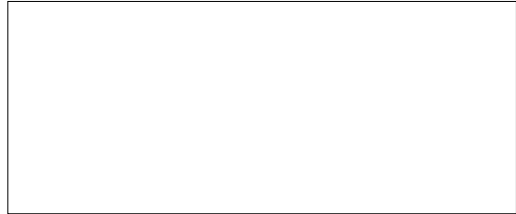
