### Youth Awareness – Community Outreach Program

The Moose Youth Awareness program has been part of the Moose fraternity for 30 years. The program is designed for high school age students (grades 9 – 12) to make a difference in their community by talking (a.k.a. Moose Talks) with younger children, ages 4 to 9, about making positive life choices. The high school students are sponsored by Moose Chapters and Lodges throughout the state by hosting regional congress informational sessions, paying for presentation expenses, and providing rewards for program completion. The scholarship money from the Virginia Moose Association (VMA) and Moose International (MI) are payable to community colleges, 4-year institutions, and certified trade schools. Student has two years after graduation to use the money, with military active duty being the only exception to the usage time line. Each year the VMA provides \$1,000 to state representatives and MI awards one \$12,000, \$8,000, \$5,000, \$3,000, and a \$2,000 (\$30,000). Additionally, the VMA provides a \$500 and \$300 cash award to two future leaders who complete the state program requirements. **What makes this program different from other scholarship programs? All prizes are selected by high school students!**

Dear Chapter Co-workers,

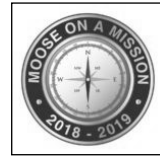
