A Year in Review for 2017-2018 (remember to view on VMA website as well)

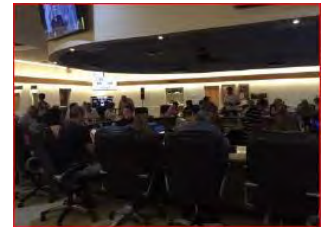

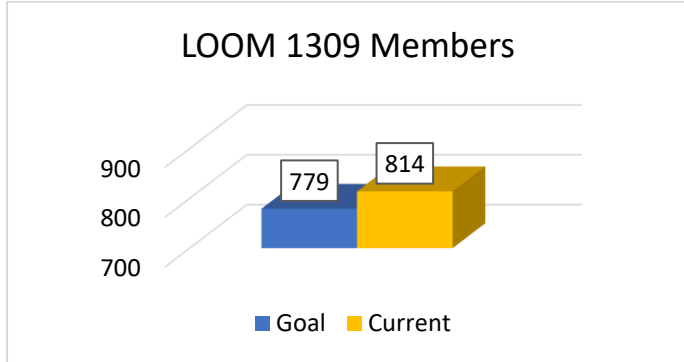

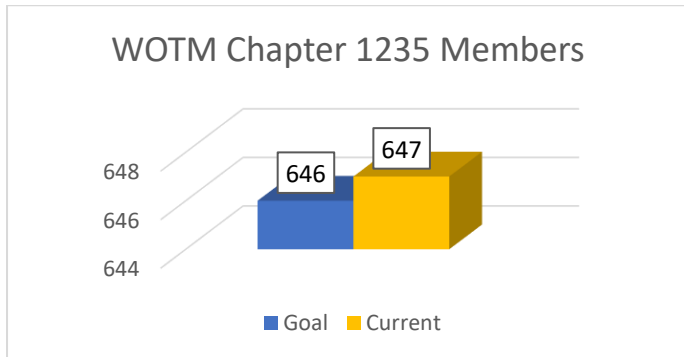
