- Third, Box Tops – these are on General Mills products as well as numerous other products. Just look for the box top clipping to cut out, and either log on to their site to donate or bring the clippings to a member of the WOTM to enter/send in.
- Last but not least, as you have heard many times before, Bingo. Wednesday’s, we have bar bingo and Sunday’s, we have bingo that is opened to the public. We are in constant need for Sunday bingo helpers and Wednesday, you are more than welcome to help with as well. The money from the Sunday bingos is used to make the donations that we do, to Mooseheart/Moosehaven and the Community.

Your primary Lodge or Chapter receives credit towards their total giving for your Donor's Circle Donations.

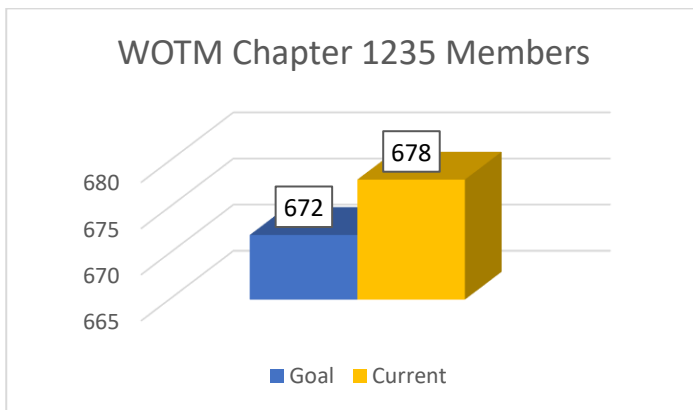
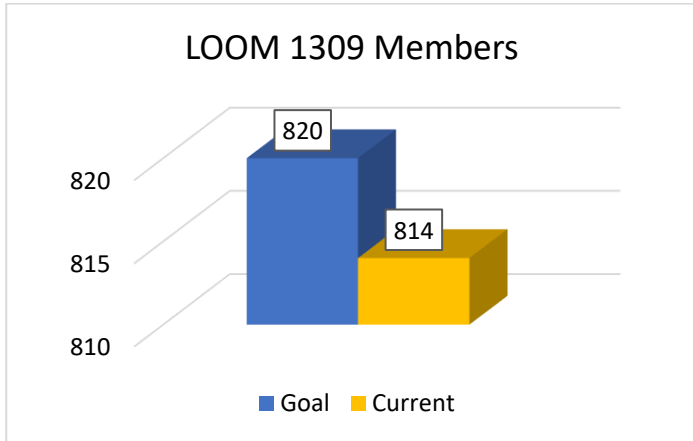

Please join us if you are a part of the Moose Legion!



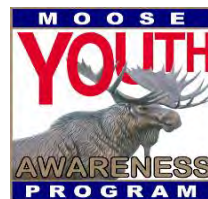
Annual Picnic in September

Youth Awareness Program



On Saturday Sept 29th starting at 12:00pm and lasting until 6 pm, there will be a Youth Awareness program starting every hour.

The program lasts approximately an hour for each session. This is an all-day event with a session starting every hour, so if you can't be there at 12:00 pm then you can still come at 3:00 pm.

All high school students (9th – 12th) grade are welcome. Parents are also encouraged to attend with student. Remember, this is for any student – they do not have to have an affiliation with the Moose.

Each student is to present a minimum of three Moose "KidsTalks" presentations from November to February. The students prepare their own message to deliver to the 4 - 9-year-olds, encouraging them to make wise and healthy choices in life.

After each "KidsTalks" presentation, the students are required to submit a written report telling us about their presentations. In March, students who attended the Association Student Congresses and completed a minimum of three "KidsTalks" presentations are judged by their peers, and one or more from each Moose Association are invited to attend the International Student Congress.

Scholarships are then awarded as follows: first, a \$12,000 scholarship; second, a \$8,000 scholarship; third, a \$5,000 scholarship; fourth, a \$3,000 scholarship; and fifth, a \$2,000 scholarship. To date, our Moose "KidsTalks" presenters have reached over 250,000 4-9 year old.

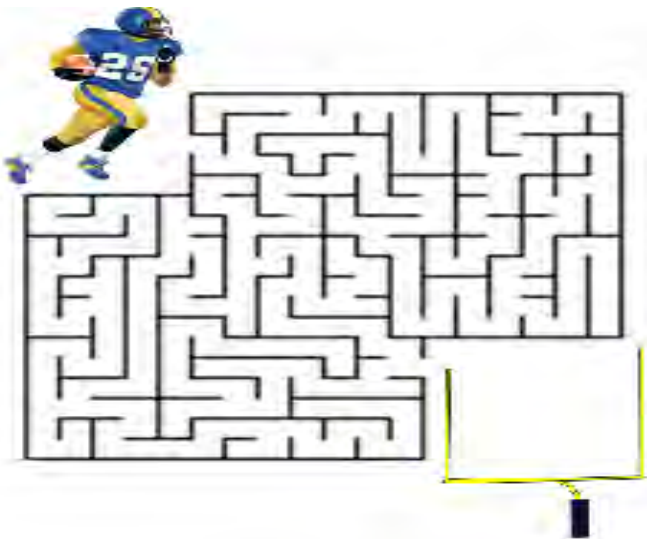

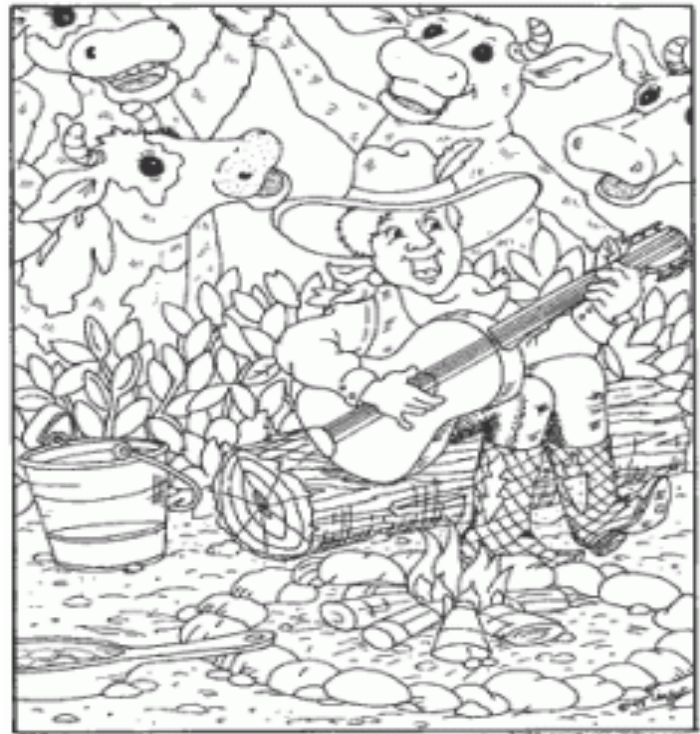
