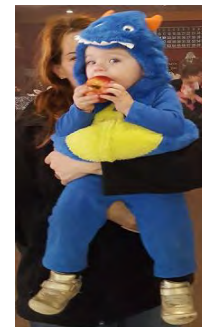

### Red Ramblers End Season and Football



On October 19<sup>th</sup>, the Mooseheart Red Ramblers held their last tackle football game with a win. Mooseheart has participated in football since 1917, and at the conclusion of the 2018 season, Mooseheart will be hanging up the shoulder pads and helmets, and moving in a different direction. The decision to eliminate football as a sport offering in our program has been discussed for the past couple seasons, and as the increased awareness and data continues to be collected nationwide (Brain Disease/CTE, better known as concussions), they felt that after the completion of the 100th year of competition it was time to end the program.

Overall, they are concerned with the amount injuries that our team has experienced this year alone. During the 2018 football season, the team, comprised of 28 players and managers, saw 8 concussions. Nearly 1/3 of their football players have had either symptoms or been diagnosed with a concussion by a medical doctor. Under the new IHSA concussion protocol requirement, students must sit out a minimum of two weeks and in some cases longer, after suffering a concussion. For Mooseheart to try and compete at the highest level of our conference, these types of decreases to their numbers cause them to utilize players who don't have much experience, therefore, increasing their chances of suffering an injury. This is a hard position from which to operate a successful program.

Also, the Northeastern Athletic Conference has continued to consider and include larger schools into the conference in which Mooseheart participates. Many participating schools have community feeder programs that develop players from an early age to the game of football. The teaching of techniques in such a physical sport is critical and often times our students have very little to no experience of football when admitting to Mooseheart and joining the team. Mooseheart doesn't have a feeder program and therefore our students are at a disadvantage from the beginning.

As I have said before, if we can get enough people to help with bingo, you would only need to work one Sunday a month.

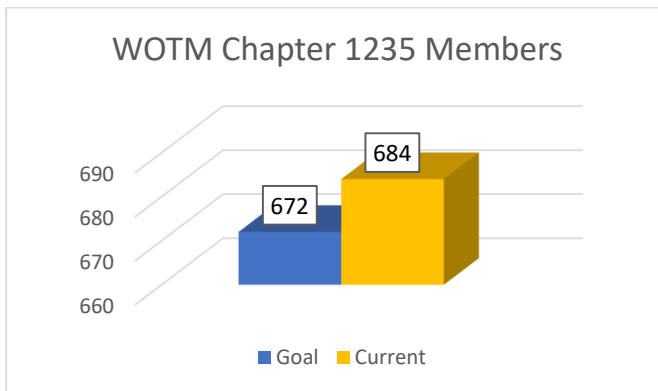
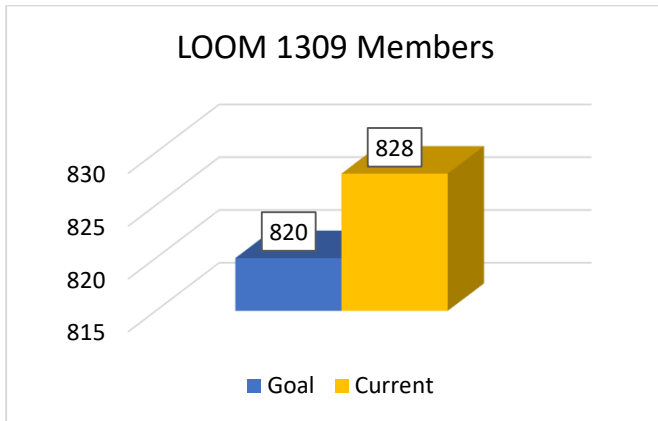

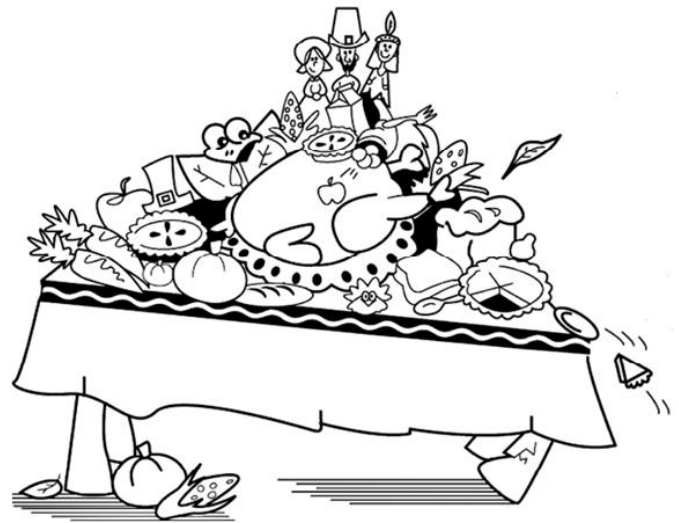
