### VMA STATE CONVENTION

Each year the Virginia Moose Association holds its annual convention. Among all of the meetings and training sessions are the presentation of awards for outstanding performance during the year along with Higher Degree conferrals. For the 2017-18 Moose Year our Lodge had the following nominations:

- Top Lodge 800+ Members
- Chapter of the Year
- Collegian of the Year (Terry Denniston)
- Star Recorder of the Year (Paulette Jones)

As background to the process, nominees are made by local committees that make a selection for each position. A write up is done on each person, Lodge or Chapter and sent to respective VMA committees for review. Prior to the convention the top contenders are notified and the winners are revealed at a banquet during the state convention.

While not selected as the state's top Lodge, we did receive the Premier Lodge Award and Heart of the Community Award. Our WOTM Chapter took home the Chapter of the Year No. 1 position for Virginia and Paulette received the Star Recorder of the Year Shining Star. In addition, the newsletter was recognized as the second-best newsletter in our membership category.

Jim Auclair and Tad Bliss were conferred with the Fellowship degree while Cher Seely received her Green Cap.
