Dec 21 - Steak and cheese made with real steak.

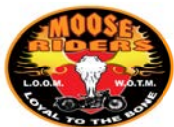

## MEMBERSHIP

“The Moose in an international organization of men and women, dedicated to caring for young and old, bringing communities together, and celebrating life.” That is how I start the explanation of what the Moose is.

One of the new offerings from the Lodge this year is the Orientation Class. Moose International realized that new members do not have a clear understanding of what the Loyal Order of Moose really is. While this has been evident to many of us for years the Office of the General Governor has decided to require the Lodges to offer an Orientation Class.

The Orientation Class gives new members an opportunity to learn about the Fraternity and the Lodge of which they have become a member. Until 2010, all new members were required to attend an Orientation Class and an Enrollment Ceremony before being issued a membership card. Since 2010, new members were issued cards based solely upon a review of their application by the Application Review Committee and a favorable vote by the membership at a general business meeting. The result was an increasing population of members who know nothing about what they just joined. Relying on the new member's sponsor to be informative was equally unsatisfactory because many of the sponsors were new members themselves and were never educated about the Fraternity. Truly a case of the blind leading the blind.

The Orientation Class takes about an hour to present. It starts with brief summary of the basic mission of the Loyal Order of Moose. It continues with some general history of the Order as well as some history of the new member's Lodge. It then explains the Officers on the Board of Officers and the various committees in the Lodge. We then continue with a description of the Higher Degrees of the Order and their importance to your progress as a member. The membership application, the private policy, and the guest registration are discussed next. The Nine O'clock Ceremony is then explained. A video from Moose International is presented to show the work of The Moose, the campus at Mooseheart, and the retirement home at Moosehaven. A short explanation of the general business meeting and its rules of order follows the video. We finish up with a question and answer

session and then go our merry ways much better informed.

All members both new and old are encouraged to attend. The next class will be held Jan. 14, 2019. Although the class is presented by the men's membership committee, the ladies are also welcome. If the Fraternity is to survive past this generation, the new members need to become familiar with and understand the true mission of The Loyal Order of Moose.

The main page, entitled MOOSE FAMILY CENTER 1655, FREDERICKSBURG VIRGINIA, is the open group and is primarily for posting Lodge events and functions. The other page is listed as MOOSE FAMILY CENTER #1655 – INTERNAL GROUP. This group was created due to posts/comments being entered on the open group that were, shall we say, “dirty laundry” – such as comments about smoking, gaming or other subjects that simply should not be made to non-members but we felt that a forum for such items would still be beneficial.

One final note on Facebook pages. There is a third option out there simply titled FREDERICKSBURG MOOSE LODGE.
