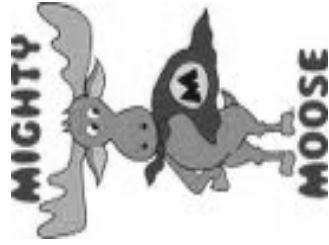

Speaking of volunteers, we need workers to help out in Bingo on Monday Nights. Please see me if you will have any available Mondays you can help us out.

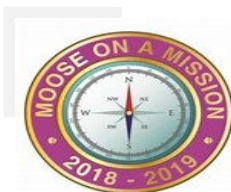

**>Nominee must be a current member of the campground, in good standing in the campground and lodge, with no probation, or major disciplinary actions in the past year. Nominee must be a registered camper.**

**>All nominees will be presented to the nominating committee, which consist of the current campground committee. On April 1<sup>st</sup> the nominating committee will decide if all nominees meet the criteria. (This meeting is strictly for the committee and not necessary for the nominees to attend).**

**>The election will be held on Sunday April 14, 2019 beginning at 2:00pm. Each campsite will be entitled to one (1) vote, using closed ballot voting procedure. The current campground committee will appoint an election committee, consisting of three (3) non-campground members to tally the votes. The winner will be announced at the campground meeting following the elections.**

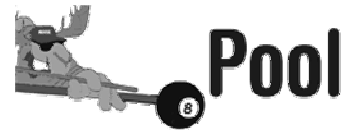
