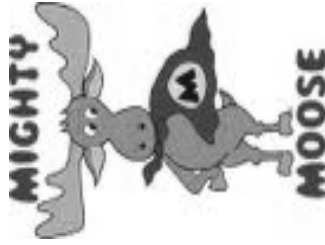

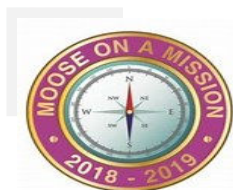

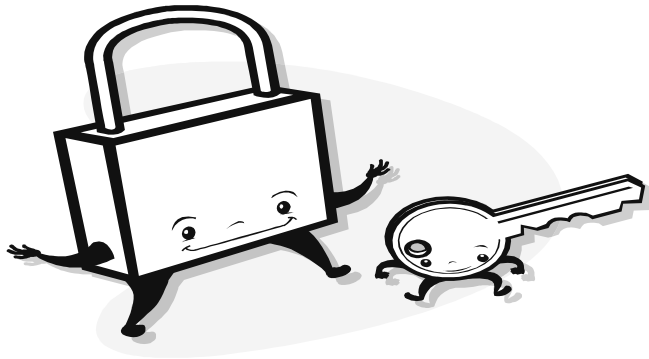

The second Lodge meeting is Wednesday, MAY 22nd, 2019 7:00pm

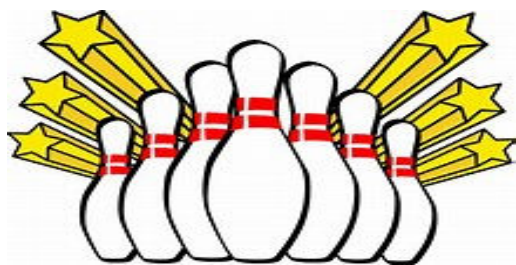

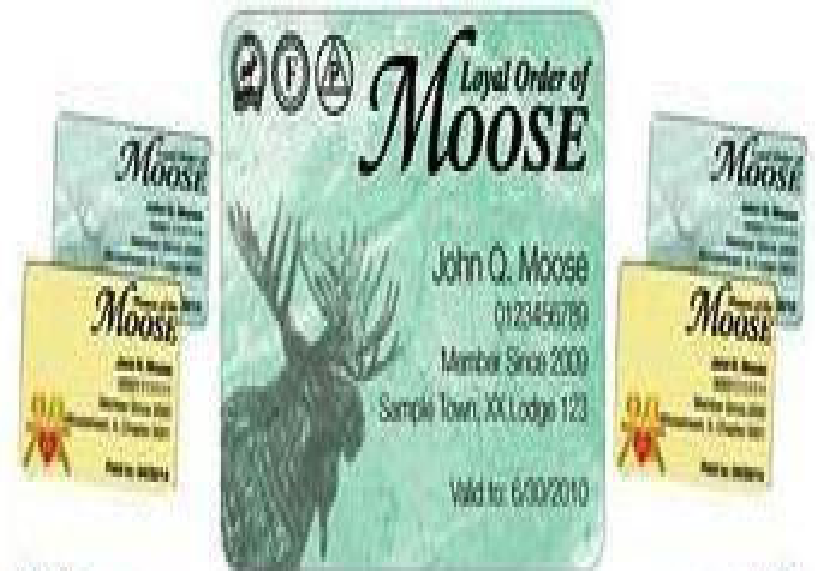
