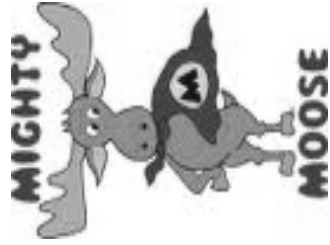

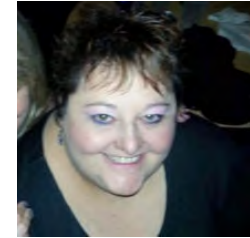

We will have the Highway Cleanup tentatively on October 14th if the Board approves this date. Watch for flyers on the bar and bulletin boards if the date changes.

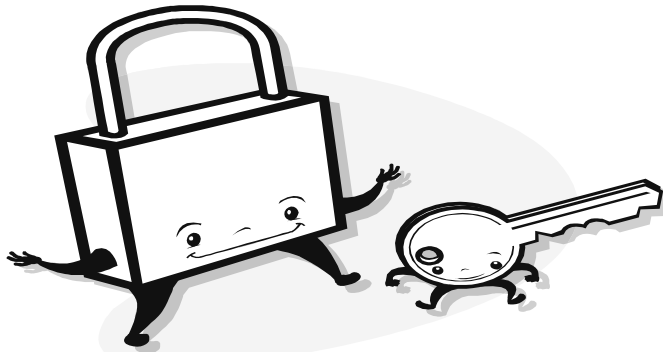

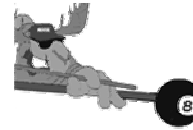
