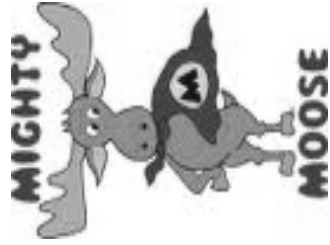

Happy Fall to All!! The Holiday Season is just around the corner. Please look at your book for Upcoming events and Lodge Holiday Closings.

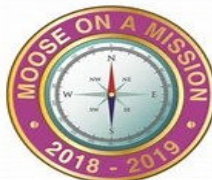

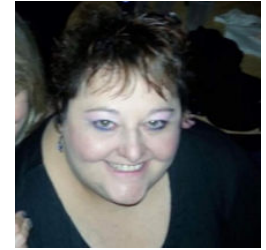

Thank you to the Governor and The Board of Directors for approving Moose Legion Projects making the Legion so great.

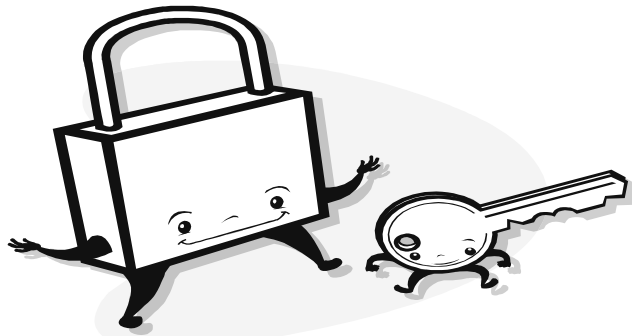

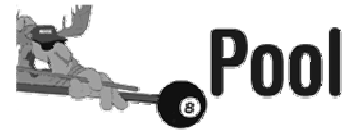
