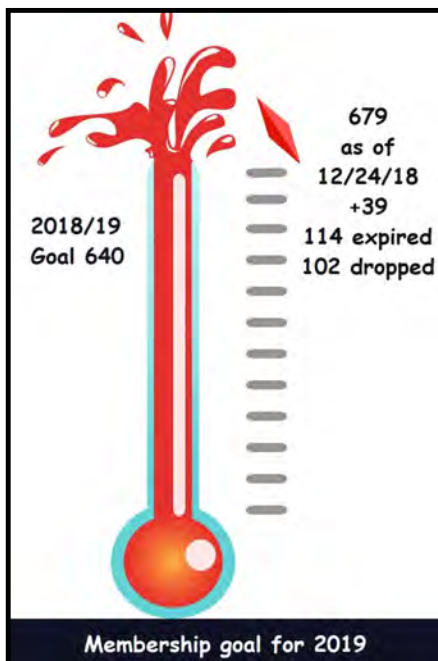

Governor's Message

Wishing all of you a heartfelt Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. This coming year promises to bring new and exciting things to the Lodge. Keep a look out for the newsletter, electronic sign, Facebook and flyers. We are looking forward to a huge year in renewed memberships as well as new members. Don't forget our membership drive will end in April. Take advantage of free application fees, and rewards for signing up new members.

New Building Update:

The PWC County Board of Supervisors approved our Special Use Permit (SUP) on December 11th. The approval of the SUP allows us to move forward and obtain the necessary permits to build our new Moose Lodge. We will be starting the final design phase. Once this is complete, the permitting process will start. Look forward to a ground-breaking ceremony and ground clearing sometime next year. For those of you that volunteered to work with Larry on the interior design, he will be reaching out to you. Our next step will be hiring a company to help us design the flow of the Lodge and maximize our space. One step forward; One step closer!

Town Hall Meeting (Smoking or Non-Smoking):

A topic that has been discussed for many years at the Lodge and within Moose International is the issue of whether we should be Smoking or Non-Smoking. There have been several attempts made over the past couple of years to decide this issue. As the Governor, I think this subject is much bigger than having just the board decide. I have asked that a Town Hall meeting be held on February 2nd at 1PM to allow all members (men and women) to discuss this issue and provide their input. A vote WILL NOT be taken on the 2nd. This is a discussion to listen to the pros and cons. It is important that we make this decision very soon as it will have a very big financial impact on the cost of the new building and the ventilation system that gets installed. Several options will be discussed during the meeting. I encourage you to attend. If you're unable to attend I would ask you share your opinion with a board member, the social quarters manager, or your bartenders. I look forward to talking with you and moving forward as a Moose Fraternity on this issue instead of the moose board deciding with no input. When the House Committee reaches a decision it will be presented at a general men's meeting to be voted on.

Lodge Charity Support:

Just a reminder that the Moose Lodge in addition to supporting Moose Heart/Moose Haven and other local charities is also providing fund raising activities for Streetlight Ministries, The Arc, and PWC Animal Shelter. We recently provided some funding to The Arc, and the Moose Riders made a sizeable donation to Streetlight Ministries. Our highlighted charity for the Month of January will be the PWC Animal Shelter. Items needed are: Pill Pockets (beef or Salmon); Cheeze Whiz (cheddar; can or spray); treats for dogs; cat or small animals; small cat toys; milk replacement for kittens or puppies (KMR); dry kitten food; bottles for kittens & puppies; pate canned cat food; frontline for dogs and cats; Capstar (flea and tick treatment); Martingale collars; Mendota slip leash; leashes; cat litter (clumping/clay); Yesterdays News litter; pine bedding; bleach and liquid laundry (HE only); dawn dish soap; Clorox/Lysol disinfecting wipes; copy paper; XL Kong/ Large Kong Wobbler; peanut butter, chicken/beef broth (ready to use). Anything you donate is acceptable and if they cannot use it they will make sure it is provided to a shelter that can. There will be a collection box by the front door to drop off donations. If you have any questions about the Animal Shelter please talk with Sue Belcher Aguero.

Plastic Caps/Box Tops:

We are collecting your plastic caps that come from sodas, and other home items such as shampoo etc. These caps will be given to the fire department who send them off to be melted down. The plastic is used to make prosthetics. It's a great way to give back and reduce our carbon foot print by not sending plastic to the land fill. Also there is a bulletin board by the back bathrooms where WOTM are collecting Box Tops for Education. If you have any, please remember to put them in the envelope.

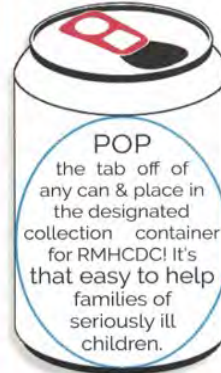


PULL FOR THE HOUSE!

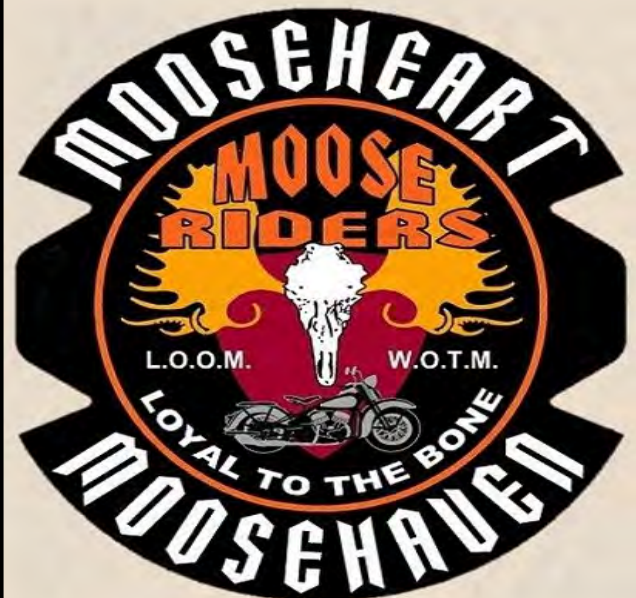
