We need to try and do a better job to keep our doors open and help us help you stay safe and healthy.

Guidelines for Re-Opening the Dale City Moose Lodge

Grounds and Parking Lot;

Social distancing of at least 6 feet must be maintained and the wearing of face masks are encouraged.

Vulnerable members, whether by age, or underlying health conditions are encouraged to stay at home.

Social Quarters;

Occupancy is restricted to 60 people to include outside seating area. Once we have reached the occupancy limit no other members will be permitted inside or outside the Social Quarters.

Sales, consumption and possession of alcohol is prohibited after 10:00 PM, therefore last call will be 9:45 PM Sunday through Saturday and the Lodge will be vacated by 10:30 PM.

Social distancing of at least 6 feet must be maintained.

Face masks are mandatory for admittance to the Lodge and shall be required anytime you are walking about the Lodge. Masks are required outdoors if safe social distancing and gathering practices are not possible.

Employees or volunteers must wear protective equipment to include face masks and gloves at all times.

Members must enter and exit the Lodge through the front door. No parking behind the building. The side gates must remain locked.

No bar seating.

All tables and gaming machines will follow social distancing guidelines. **Moving of tables and chairs is forbidden. Only 4 people per table and no congregating at the ends of the tables.**

Wipe down games consoles before and after use.

All drink glasses will be plastic and will be disposed of, in designated trash cans, by the members themselves.

The Daily and Weekly Book game will be suspended until further notice.

Hand sanitizers will be placed at several location within the lodge. Members and employees are encouraged to use this product often during their visit.

A plexiglass shield will be installed to separate bartender and patrons.

Vulnerable members, whether by age, or underlying health conditions are encouraged to stay at home.






















Tommy Time- DCMR-President
