

Governor's Message:

NO SMOKING On March 30th the general membership voted and approved to have no smoking in the new building except for designated areas. As of today, the designated areas will be a smoking room and the deck off the back of the building. There will be a vote at the International Conference in June in which all lodges will vote to not permit smoking in the lodges. Moose International has not put out the language on the proposal. We have heard that they may only allow smoking outside of the lodge. Right now, we are going to proceed with our plans as approved by the general membership

In the interim the Board of Officers has installed Larry as the acting administrator. As soon as the new board is in place we will address the long term need of the administrator position.

NEW BUILDING DEDICATION Put this one on your calendar. We will hold a ground breaking ceremony on 22 June 2019 at 3PM. We will have events for the family starting at 1PM. Following the ceremony everyone is invited to a free dinner and rolled back prices to 1979 in the social quarters. Following dinner, we will have a band. The new building has been a long time coming. We have been working with Garcia Construction and the Prince William County Planning office for over 2 years. The final plans are almost complete. The site permit request was submitted to the County on April 1st.

Members are required to show their membership card upon entering to the bartender or door guard


Only the following persons may be admitted as a "qualified guest' into the social quarters of the lodge:

1. A good standing Lodge or Chapter member's spouse or son/daughter under 21 years of age. There is no limit to the times they may visit the SQ.
2. Prospective members. They are any guest that is accompanied by a member who can sponsor them for membership in the Order. A prospective member's second visit must be accompanied with an application into the Order and all fees and dues must be paid.
3. Qualified guests must be signed in.
4. Qualified guests must be accompanied by the member at all times, can not make purchases, play tickets or ticket machines and must leave when their sponsor leaves.

Pull-Tabs and video pull tabs are for Members only.

No alcohol beverages will be brought into the lodge from outside.

No beverages may be brought outside of, or consumed outside of, the lodge premises with the exception of the fenced in area at the rear of the Lodge.
