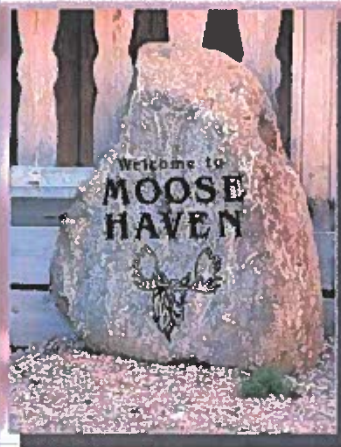


Moose—On A Mission

Voted and approved are the following results of these complaints:

What does Membership Retention mean? How do I increase membership retention? These are just a few of questions that we ask each day regarding retention. The simple answer is "Get all of your members more connected and engaged."... The word retention is a derivative of "Retain" which comes from an Old French word meaning to keep "attached to one's person, to keep in service."

Keep members active and involved. Invite new members to a monthly meeting and/or waive their application fee. Plan orientations for new members at meetings, plan special events/activities for Moose Legionnaires or new members.

Which is more valuable to our Fraternity? One new member or one retained member. Both are correct, but we can't just do it on new members alone, we need to retain the ones that we have.

Here are a few suggestions on how to retain in your Lodge:

Discover why they joined. Refresh the member's showing them the benefits that we offer. Send out a "win-back" notice; let them know we miss them and want to get them back involved or better yet, pick up the phone and give them a personal call, see what we can do to get them back!

When you sign a member up, get them involved right away, invite them to a dinner, an event, or just introduce them to other Moose members around and ask for them to help get them involved. Remember it takes more than one to do the work. It takes all of us to make ODML#148 great again!
